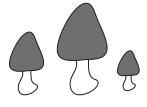

The world of fungus is a wild and wacky place! Discover the secrets of Manning's "Underground"!



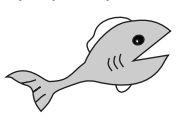

To face the challenges of life in Manning Park, the plants and animals here have developed incredible superpowers! Find out who uses their powers for good... or evil!!!

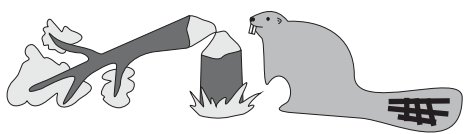

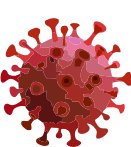
