

FISHING REGULATIONS AROUND E.C. MANNING PARK

Okanagan Region #8:

Similkameen River

- Daily Quota: 5, but not more than:
 - 1 over 50cm
 - 4 from streams (only 2 over 30cm)
- Wild rainbow trout release between Hwy#3 bridge at Princeton and Hwy 33 bridge 31km below Princeton
- **Bait Ban:** April 1- October 31, exempt from Spring Closure

Lower Mainland Region #2:

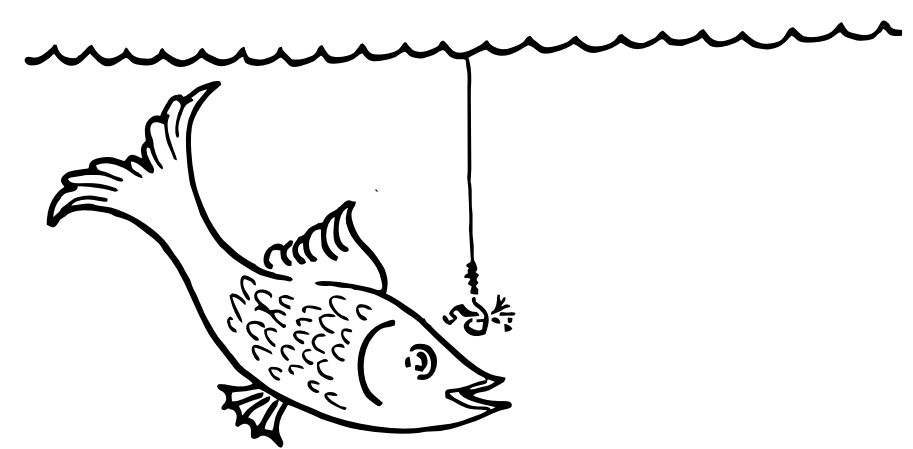
Daily Quota: 4, but not more than:

- 1 over 50cm (2 steelhead over 50 cm allowed)
- 2 from streams (must be hatchery)
- 1 Char (Bull Trout, Dolly Varden, or Lake Trout)

You must release:

- Wild Trout/Char from streams
- all Wild Steelhead\
- Trout/Char under 30cm from streams (must be hatchery)

NOTE: There is no general minimum size for trout in lakes



Lightning Lake, Flask Lake, Strike Lake, Thunder Lake & Poland Lake

- NO POWER BOATS of any kind!

Sumallo River

- No fishing November 1- June 30
- Bait Ban
